

2006 HUMAN POWER CHALLENGE UPDATES AND NEWS



Great News for the Riders of Homebuilts!

The Human Power Challenge race committee has earmarked a \$10 bonus to the 1st rider crossing the finish line on a homebuilt in the following three races:

- Road Race
- Time Trial
- 200 Meter Sprint

The bonus is offered in all classes; stock, super stock, super street, streamliner, in both the men's and women's divisions. Another possible 24 payouts! You don't have to place in the race (1st, 2nd, or 3rd); you may be 10th in the race but 1st on a homebuilt! To qualify, your bike must be a ground up, from scratch, machine. The main frame (or chassis) cannot be a "manufactured" frame. A homebuilt tour easy clone is OK, though. Get the idea? The tech inspector and/or committee representative will have discretionary powers to make a ruling on your rig, ergo, if you want it to be eligible as a homebuilt, make it as one! By the way, we will be looking carefully at the welds and epoxy joints. Remember, we gotta have insurance on "all" the bikes, so make it clean and solid!
